Our verse today is Psalms 34:1

Psa. 34:1 I will extol YHWH at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.

Giving YHWH praise. What an awesome thing to do. What a needed thing to do. I constantly tell my children how we should always do our best in spending time with our heavenly Father. We should take advantage of every opportunity to spend time with Him.
