Content? - Revelation 3:15-19

Rev. 3:15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other! 16 So, because you are lukewarm — neither hot nor cold — I am about to spit you out of my mouth. 17 You say, 'I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.' But you do not realize that you are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked. 18 I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich; and white clothes to wear, so you can cover your shameful nakedness; and salve to put on your eyes, so you can see. 19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest, and repent.

These were the words spoken to the church of Laodicea. A church that seems pretty content with their walk. A church that believes they're doing good. A church that felt they had no needs. Yet, Yeshua said they were wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked. Pretty strong words for people who thought all was good. What do you say of yourself?
