Prov. 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall.

In Numbers 16 we read about Korah's rebellion. He was a Levite who thought too highly of himself and was basically jealous of Aaron. He wanted to be a priest like Aaron and his sons. His pride and arrogance brought judgement not only on himself but his whole family as well.
