Tomorrow - Proverbs 27:1

Prov. 27:1 Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth.

What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. 15 Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." 16 As it is, you boast and brag. All such boasting is evil.

But why is it evil? It's because it's prideful. It's declaring things as fact when that person doesn't know what the facts are. Pride will always prove to be a downfall in ones life if it's not kept in check.
