1 Timothy 6:10 - Love of Money

1Tim. 6:10 For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

First, let it be known that it's not money that is the root of all evil. It's the love of money. Big difference. The question for us should be "What is the love of money?"

I know that may sound like a silly question, however, I can't help but wonder what Paul considered the "love of money" was. Very few believers would consider themselves a lover of money. However, is that really the case? Let's not forget Yeshua's caution in Luke 12:15.
